Communication is the key to having an effective Locale. Reminder to the Officers and Directeur's, get your news articles in by the dead line, so we have good communication with our membership. Your work is not done, tell the paperwork is done. Speaking of paperwork, let me remind the Locale Correspondants that you make or break the Locale, as far as the reports to the Grande goes. Your Office is a major part of the Locale. It's not just taking the minutes and reading them back at the next Promenade. It's up to you to see they are done, correct and timely. It's also on you to see that all reports are also done, correct and timely.

Don't wait tell the last minute to gather what you will need. Over the course of the year, keep some notes on what your Locale has done. Not every Locale does every-thing, but you do something. Keep notes. **Examples:** your locale was at the Veterans Day event in your area, Memorial Day event, Color Guard, Honor Guard, sponsored a Nurse, Community events, etc. This is all reportable on one or more of the reports. Not only should you get as much of this in your Locale news, to let others in your area know what you've done, it's important that we send this information up the chain by reporting. Also, other veterans see this in your local paper, hear about the 40 et 8 on the news, they will also want to be part of a group of veterans that are active in local events. Another report that is sometimes slow to come in is your **Certification of Officers and Delegate's to Grand Promenade.** They need to be completed and sent in, so the Grande knows who to get in contact with, to pass on information that your Locale needs to know. The same goes with Delegates. The Grand needs to know who they are. so they can register quickly up on arrival. On the Officer Certifications and Delegate form, they are to be sent to the Grand Correspondant by JUNE 1st, NOT Nationale. Nationale DOES NOT send that information back to the Grande. Later on in the year, Nationale does ask you to send them a copy of who you're Officers will be and delegates to Nationale later on around mid to latter July/August. Also, the Grand Directory cannot be put out/correctly without this information.

GRANDE FALL CHEMINOT MEETING

Country Inn and Suites Sandusky-South

October 4, 2025

Grand Chef de Gare Todd P. McIlrath opened the Grande Cheminot Meeting in proper form at 9:00 a.m. The Colors being in place, the Grand Chef de Gare asked Grande POW Directeur to Place the cover on the empty Chair. Grand Aumonier Webb offered the Divine Blessing.

Grand Conducteur Felty introduced the National Officers and Distinguished Guests that were present:

Roll call was then called by Grand Correspondant Cook.

A notion was offered by Rivera and seconded by Felty to suspend with the reading of minutes of the last Cheminot and Grand Prom, as they were in the last issue of the Ohio 40et8er. Notion passed.

Reports of the Grande Officers were given as follows:

Grand Chef de Train Harold Wade Jr., there has been no report out yet from Nationale. He handed out membership awards received after the Grand Prom. Kronen stated that David Burnett asked to be transferred to V 498. Frank looking into. The Grand Chef de Train offered a notion his report be accepted, the notion was 2nd and passed. Grand Chef announced that V 498 won award at Nationale for membership.

Grand Commissaire Intendant Dolwig went over his report. Beginning Balance (June 27th) of \$6,016.32 ending Balance (Oct.2nd) of \$3,901.18. Savings Beginning (June 27th) \$80,702.59 and ending (Oct.2nd) 80,703.13. Total Balance (Oct. 2) Checking & Savings \$84,604.31 and American Funds \$108,492.00. Total Assets \$193,096.31. He offered a notion to except report. Seconded. By Felty. Notion Passed.

Grand Avocat: Spider- No Report.

Grand Americanism: Grand Chef read the report sent in by Kovchick- We had received 43 reports by the July 15th Dead Line. You the Voyageur Militaire are the back bone of Americanism. With your support

purchase of pins, going into schools and teaching first graders about the Nationale ting them to give me information symbol, the American Flag, helping out locale boy scouts, running/supporting blood drives. He then talked on Time and Place- Again this year will be Gettysburg and then Kansas next two years after that. 2027 \$132 .00 per night and 2028 \$130.00 per night.

Grande Carville Star Harold Wade Jr.- At Nationale it was handed out a star Magazine folder with applications to buy a Country or sponsor a hospital in support of Carville Star Program. Curator at the Carville Star Museum unexpectedly retired, having trouble finding replacement. Next Year at Promenade Nationale a Carville Star traveling exhibit will be there (Hopefully) Water Buffalos in India, Red Squirrels in England and Mice worldwide have found out recently can transmit leprosy to humans. Finaly, Nationale Directeur retiring from program after many years of faithful service. He offered a notion to except report, seconded. Notion Passed.

Child Welfare: Spider reported He did not get to go to Nationale, but had the following report-Now that school has started again, it's kids' sports events time. These events keep kids busy all year. Even if your locale does not have the money to donate, your time to help with events and or even show up to watch them, this is all valuable in reporting on your report. I know we have grand kids, even scout troops, they sell cookies or other items, that's your donation. Remember, our yearly report to Nationale shows we are concerned with children in our state. He then offered a notion to except report, seconded. Notion Passed. He has pins for \$3.00 ea. or two for \$5.00. Grand Chef stated had ordered 2K pins was reported at Nationale.

Constatation Bylaws- No Report

Grand Activates: Felty-Hospitality room open after meeting. Will Close for Banquet and reopen soon after ends.

Grand Chef reported on meeting at Nationale- only had 6 attends. It was brought up need moer scrap books only had one this year. New award pins on vets. More you have better chance of winning. Must be worn, not photo of.

Nurses Training: Todd P. Mcilrath need up dated emails for chef de Gars and Correspondant's to get info out. Gave out scholarships out to 37 nurses. Each Grand can get 6K from Boland fund. He offered a notion to except his report. It was seconded. Notion Passed.

POW/MIA Harold Wade Jr. -\$37,000 was donated to this program last year. 26 scholarships were handed out last year, which was up from last year. The trust fund now has \$247,000. Reports submitted last year were up to 25 states. From state reports, over 1000,000 miles were driven and 48,272-man hours were used. All you need to do is submit request 3 times to receive scholarship. He offered a notion to except report, seconded. Notion Passed.

Grand Publiciste / Public Relations Rivera No Report.
